We will be traveling to India on April 22 to work with our ministry partner, Gospel Friends. During this time, we will have wonderful opportunities to encourage and challenge our brothers and sisters in the Bible College and Nursing School as they move into the next phase of their lives.



We will also be assisting with one of the largest vacation Bible schools in the world. Almost 6000 children from different religious backgrounds gather for a week to

learn the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The impact of the VBS is eternal. One girl who hated Christians, mainly because her father was a Hindu priest, was encouraged by a friend to attend VBS. It was here that she accepted Jesus as her savior, was baptized, and changed her name to Mercy.


