“Establishing Fruit that Remains” in Nepal

The Partnership Begins

In 2012, we began conversations with James Poudel, Chairman of the Dhankuta Christian District and an Elder in the Aashish Presbyterian Church of Kathmandu. After over a year of building a relationship via phone and email and discussing the possibility of establishing a ministry partnership, the CWM Executive Director and Director of Outreach visited James and his family in Nepal. They also had opportunities to teach and lead a three-day women's conference.

Soon after returning home, the CWM leadership council approved a formal partnership with James's ministry.

Our Ministries

Christian World Missions currently supports two ministry positions in Nepal.

One position, held by Lydia Poudel, includes teaching, preaching, leading women's ministry in a Presbyterian church in Pakhribas, leading house fellowships and coordinating special events such as regional women's conferences.



The second position is held by Sunitha Shrestha. She will lead the nondenominational church fellowship in Deurali village, serve as secretary of the Women in Dhankuta District and conduct evangelistic outreach in villages.



By providing financial and spiritual support to this ministry, we are establishing fruit that remains in Nepal. The Gospel is being shared with those who have not heard and disciples are being made to continue to spread the Good News of Christ.

Women's Conference

Some women traveled for several days to attend the three-day women's conference. We were blessed by their desire to hear God's Word and willingness to allow the Spirit to move in them. We look forward to leading another conference in Eastern Nepal soon.
