You know all the things that happen through your ministry: establishing new churches; caring for orphans; providing education for children, and pastors.

You know our mission statement: *Producing Fruit that Remains*You might even know our motto: *Caring, Witnessing, Making Disciples*And *I* certainly know all of these things, and the Word that led us to such a time and place as this.

But sometimes, God makes the old and familiar become brand new! Do you ever suddenly see a Scripture passage as if it were brand new? I had that happen this morning with a passage I know I've read at least 100 times, and probably many more!

In India and Nepal, Ghuna Kumar and Ganesh Poudel are regularly leading Hindus to Christ, baptizing entire families sometimes!

But it struck me today – we certainly couldn't say that there are no churches in North Starkville, so why are we making the effort here? My dear friend, John Zimmerman, said it best this morning: *Some of our neighbors have never heard the name of Jesus spoken in love*. Think about that. Churches on every corner, and yet, there are still those who have never truly heard the Name of Jesus: *Wonderful Counselor, Prince of Peace, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Emmanuel*.

"Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved. But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent?" (Romans 10:14-15, NLT)

Whether it's Across the Street or Around the World, I want them to hear. I know you feel the same way! Thank you for helping us spread the news!
