"When she picked up the students from school that day, she found him sobbing. A skin disease that covered most of his body caused him to wear long sleeves and pants every day, even in the hottest summer. The kids had all made fun of him and his heart was bleeding. This wasn't the first time, and it probably wouldn't be the last. She rose up like a mother tiger defending her cubs. She would love him and make sure he knew how precious he was, uniquely made in the image of God. Last week, that same boy sang a solo for a group of our partners. He is finding the Door of Hope.



The girl hung her head and refused to answer. The tutor tried to draw her out, but the girl just kept her heart hidden inside the hard shell, until that day, after months of faithful, tender kindness, she looked up and smiled. She belonged, and she knew it. A child who was in the lowest special education class in her school is now reading fluently in front of crowds. Love helps you recognize the Door of Hope and enter to find your destiny.

Needs threaten to overwhelm us, but through prayer, God opens a door of hope for every person. Prayer is how we come to know Who God is and what God is doing in our midst. It is how He shapes our hearts to love.
