# Living Hope Theological College - India

When only 3% of your nation is Christian, training for spiritual leadership can be very hard to come by! Our college provides Bachelors, Masters, and Doctoral level studies for future pastors, evangelists, and Christian educators. Traveling in secret from Nepal, and Myanmar to join students in South India, the students are thoroughly equipped to share the Gospel in their countries.

Suggested Gift: \$50/student/month or \$300/student/term

### Sewing School and Sewing Machine - Asia

Women in Third World countries face great adversity, injustice, poverty, abuse, and neglect. Young women can help to support their families with a cottage sewing business. Widows can live in dignity, earning a living, rather than being forced into starvation, prostitution, or begging.



Suggested Gift: \$100/student/full course



## Jaya Nursing Institute - India

The Jaya Nursing Institute educates young women and men to address the health problems people in India may have because of little or no access to medical care. Enrollment is aimed at students who

would otherwise be denied an education due to poverty or societal barriers. Since 2010, 7 classes of at least 60 students have graduated and now serve in rural areas. Many are also serving as evangelists in villages where there is no Christian witness.

Suggested Gift: \$50/student/month or \$300/student/term

### Living Hope School - India

With 250 students enrolled, the Living Hope school provides a high quality education, Pre-K through grade 10. The school serves as an outreach to the villages surrounding the Living Hope campus, where many students would otherwise be unable to receive an education. The school has a quality curriculum,

supplies, teachers, and also offers transportation to and from school. Most of the students come from Hindu homes, but they respond willingly to the opportunity to attend a Christian school. Education is just one more tool that helps the poorest of the poor begin to grasp the hope and future that God has planned for them.

Suggested Gift: \$20/child/month

# Making Disciples - International

### Establishing New Churches

"I appointed you to go and bear fruit that remains." (John 15:16) If new followers of Christ do not quickly find a community of believers, they often fall away for lack of nurture and instruction. Since 1976, CWM has partnered with indigenous Christian movements to establish well over 2000 new

churches. We assist with purchase of land or construction of their initial structure, as much as 3 years salary for the pastor, a Bible, and a bicycle or motorcycle.

### Youth and ChildRen's MinistRies

Children are universally curious, eager for attention, and willing to learn new things. They are very often the gateway to reach entire families and villages. In Africa, youth are learning to help senior citizens establish cottage industries, benefitting both generations. In Nepal, they go into villages to present health and cultural programs. In India, more than 4000 children gather for a week-long Vacation Bible School each May. We are

### Open Air Evangelism

"But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?" (Romans 10:14)



Through story-telling, testimonies, and preaching, we proclaim God's Word in cities and remote villages all around the world, often in areas that are hostile to the Gospel. Your gifts provide support for an evangelist to do house-to-house

visits for weeks before the actual open-air event, rental of tents, sound equipment, chairs, and musical instruments, and to purchase banners, radio spots, and newspaper ads to get the word out. Since 1986, CWM and our partners have established more than 2000 new congregations around the world.

### Bore-Hole Evangelism

"Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." (John 4:13-14) For villagers who spend up to 6 hours a day fetching water for their families, access to local, clean water is truly a gift of life. A great

celebration is held for the entire village to dedicate the well, and at that time, we take the opportunity to tell them about Jesus, the Living Water. A new church is begun!

## Free Medical Clinics

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people." (Matthew 4:23) Many people experience God's love through seeing His healing power at work, whether through prayer or medicine. Of course, we always pray for the sick, but we also occasionally conduct temporary, free medical clinics.

These clinics offer assistance for minor illnesses and injuries, but they often diagnose serious illnesses and make referrals, even providing financial assistance to poor families.

Suggested Gift: \$300/3-day medical clinic





Christian World Missions at Home

Beginning in June 2015, we launched a daily program for junior high youth to be in a healthy, loving environment. This is a place for Bible study, character growth, mentoring, service learning, and tutoring — and lots and lots of fun! We have seen our students come to know Christ, improve school performance, learn to manage their behavior, and begin to gain a vision for what God's future for them might be. As they age-out

of YCE, they enter a weekly program designed to help high school students navigate the world of new responsibilities, opportunities, and temptations. Partnering with many local volunteers and organizations, we are able to provide a comprehensive life-learning ministry for these amazing young people.

Suggested Gift: \$50

## Community Outreach Center

The CWM Center sits in the middle of some of Starkville's most needy neighborhoods. Our 10.000 sq. ft. warehouse is being renovated into a 2-story facility that will include more than 10,000 sq ft of classroom and office space, and a 7500 sq. ft. multi -purpose room. Once completed, we can expand YCE and add additional community outreach programs; host concerts, spiritual growth conferences, and fund-raising banquets. The facility will also be available to rent for family reunions, weddings, receptions, and other events, and the income generated will help to fund all of our ministries. We are close to completion, but need approximately \$125,000 to be completely debt-free.


## Leadership & Women's Conferences
