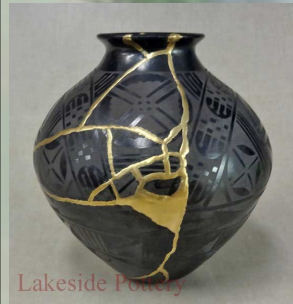
Our Speaker
