Can you believe it? The grass outside my office window is turning green! Well, it's actually just clover, but it's a promising sign of new life to come!



As you know, the news from Nigeria, Pakistan, and India is equally dire, and Christians are facing persecution daily in those countries and many others. What can we do for our precious brothers and sisters? Here are 5 Practical Ways to help the persecuted church:



- Educate yourself My favorite sources are www.opendoorsusa.org and www.persecution.com (Voice of the Martyrs).
- 2. Pray Pray for strength, boldness, encouragement, faith, strong fellowship, provision for daily needs. Pray for governments to bow to Jesus.
- 3. Inform your church Encourage others to become advocates and prayer warriors for our suffering brothers and sisters. Think of creative ways to focus on the issue: an annual worship service, a monthly prayer meeting.
- 4. Write letters Write letters of encouragement to suffering believers. Write letters of advocacy to government, human rights, and religious freedom organizations.
- 5. Invest Identify a missionary or people group and develop a relationship with them. Find out their needs and do what you can to help them. Give to
