



This year, you have built 6 worship pavilions in Nigeria, and helped to finish construction on two worship centers in India. You also added toilet facilities to one worship center in Nepal and helped to complete renovations on another.

You baptize hundreds of new believers each year. Most of them are turning to Christ from other religions, sometimes at

great personal cost. But all of them celebrate their new life in Christ and find the cost to be minimal compared to the riches they find in Jesus.



You give vision to dozens of at-risk teens in Mississippi so that they can discover their God-given destiny. Many would be stuck in the endless cycle of poverty, addiction, incarceration, and hopelessness, but you make it possible for them to experience God's unconditional love and learn to walk in His promises.



You have done all of these things, and so much more through Christian World Missions! I know there are countless other ways you have shared God's love and given God glory. And to think, He has been shaping you for this since before the foundations of the earth!

The local youth program more than doubled in number, and we are already close to reaching full capacity in registrations for the fall. Nepal, India, and Pakistan are all reporting regular baptisms of new believers, and Nigeria is reporting a great move of the Spirit in preparation for new church planting this fall.

Lori Smith, Associate Evangelist and Director of Finance for CWM, spent four weeks this summer helping her parents get medical diagnoses and treatment, and then moving into a senior living center. God opened doors very quickly for them to live just one mile from Lori's brother in a home with several friends from years past. It is not an exaggeration to say that ministry is exploding with all five of our outreaches, and we are faithfully providing support to them and completing construction of the Storehouse debt-free. In order to do this, Lori and I have both committed ourselves to seeing ministry advance, even if it means that we sometimes don't get our salaries.
