The enemy will try any tactic to discourage us, but we must stand fast and wait on the strength of the Lord! These orphan children know from Whom their strength comes, and they are praying for us! Let us remember them in our prayers, too.

I remember a little ditty Evangelist Dr. Jack Gray used to teach: "Sometimes you feel like you are the only one. 111. And when your Enemy, 666, comes along, you feel like he could eat you up. But remember, God is on your side and His number is 777! So, when 111 joins with 777, that makes 888, and you can gobble up 666!"
