

Suddenly, in addition to funds needed to complete the building, CWM is now faced with additional expenses of cleaning-up the building and improving outside drainage to ensure this situation does not repeat itself. More fund-raising is now needed.

Of course, we will NOT cancel the trip to Washington. Our youth have worked hard to help raise the funds for the trip, and they still have other fund-raisers planned. But now, we have an urgent need for funds to simply keep things going here at home. We also have a waiting list for our youth program, but until we complete those rooms, we cannot add any more children. And until the drainage problem is addressed, we cannot complete the rest of the building.
