Dear Friends,

God hasn't forgotten us! Hallelujah! Hanging above my desk is a card printed for me several years ago by our dear secretary at the time, Rosella Goddard: "God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him as you have helped His people and continue to help them." (Hebrews 6:10)

Sometimes, it's hard to hold onto the certainty that God has not forgotten. Indeed, He has "a plan to prosper us, and not to harm us; to give us hope and a future." (Jeremiah 29:11)

Over the past month, we have been reminded again and again that God has not forgotten. A gift was made that completely paid off the debt of the ministry. In Pakistan, Nepal, and India, dozens have received Christ, in spite of great personal risk. We received an almost-new washer and dryer for the ministry in Starkville, paying only a fraction of their worth. In Pakistan, several received miraculous healings after the team prayed for them – and they became followers of Christ!

These blessings strengthen our faith as we walk through the on-going opportunities for ministry the Lord brings to us. I'm going to hit the highlights, this month, and ask you to pray earnestly for each situation:

- \$19,000 to be able to meet our full obligations in **Nigeria** this year, which includes starting 5 new churches, building at least 3 more pavilions, and meeting salary for the director and the new pastors.
- \$15,000 to complete flooring in upstairs areas of **The Storehouse**
- Unspecified funds to help with reconstruction and repair of churches and homes in **Nepal and India** following this season's monsoonal flooding
- Two opportunities for outreach in the **Starkville** community in October
- On-going need for support in **Pakistan** to provide Bibles, clothing, and food supplies

And, finally, I ask for your prayers as I have total knee replacement this Friday, September 6. I am grateful for family and friends who have already offered to help. And I am grateful for you, and your on-going help, support, and prayers for Christian World Missions. You are a blessing!
